

Director Of Missions Business meeting 2/17/07

Collective, intense, sincere, earnest prayer was offered for David and Susanne Clippard and for Director of Missions Jim Cogdill. Testimonies concerning the moving of the Spirit of god were shared by the Directors of Missions.

Tommy Blair shared the financial report. He noted that \$1,242.71 was transferred to Home Town Bank after George Roach turned over the accounts to Bro. Blair. A Federal I. D. number has been obtained; and, the current balance stands at \$1,748.97 in the D.O.M. account. Al Groner noted that a check for \$400 should be written to the Fair Committee, of which Marlin Brown is the Treasurer.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved as printed and as presented.

Reports:

Patrick Ryan, chairman fo the State Fair Committee expressed concern that the DOMs may not be able to give out water and Koolaid at the State Fair this year. He noted that fair officials had nixed this idea; they also said our trailer could not be used on our site. The State Fair Committee will be meeting soon to determine what changes in our program and ministry are needed. Ministry times have been set from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 2-4 p.m.

DOMs were urged to pay their yearly dues.

NEW BUSINESS:

Al Groner made a motion that a recommendation (attached to this report) in support of Dr. Clippard and the MBC team be approved by the Directors of Missions Fellowship. The motion also asked that the recommendation, if approved, to be sent to al MBC Executive Board members, to all MO Mission Directors, and to the news media for publication. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Curtis Townley made a motion that the 8th and 9th of April be set aside as days of prayer and of fasting in spiritual preparation for the very critical April 10th MBC Executive Board meeting. All MO Mission Directors would be asked to join in this prayer vigil. The motion also asked that, if approved, the announcement of the days of prayer and of fasting would be sent to every DOM, every association, every associational moderator in Missouri. The motion was seconded by Frank Welch. It was noted that very critical meetings of the MBC Administrative Committee and other vital MBC committee would take place on April 9th. The motion passed unanimously.

Roy Spannagel reminded the Directors Of Missions about important dates on the DOM calendar including:

- DOM Spring Conference February 19-20, 2008
- DOM Fall Conference October 7-9. 2008 (a change in date)
- MBC Annual Meeting October 27-29. 2008

Jim Plymale suggested that DOMs infested in partnering across associational boundaries for intrastate mission work to contact him.

The motion was made to adjourn the meeting; a second was offered; and, the motion passed.
